Budget Surprises - 2021

_	\$2000	Signage wood Rot – Pian was to just touch up paint
_	\$1900	Tree work requested by homeowners and neighboring subdivisi

Tree work requested by homeowners and neighboring subdivision, front entrance trees are encroaching on neighbor's house and dead trees at common ground edges required removal, fall risk

\$740 Irrigation & Electrical Repairs

\$500 Website Upgrade – required by host

\$445 Legal Fees – consultation on commercial vehicles

+ \$667 Liability Insurance Savings

Front Entrance Signs

- Extensive deep wood rot in letters
- Repaired with wood hardener & epoxy
- Will require annual maintenance/painting

Rear Entrance Signs

- South facing sign, more damage
- Supports on back severely rotted
- Rotting at joints. Have had to completely disassemble & epoxy

Future Sign Replacement?

- \$60k+/- estimated to replace all three signs
 - Winnett's guess, no contractor estimates
 - Can we find a woodworking shop to duplicate?
 - \$14k each estimated 4 years ago to duplicate wood with foam casting
 - \$13k each for much smaller non-custom metal signs, Nantucket subdivision
 - Replacement will require a Special Assessment
 - \$60k would require \$650 per household (91 homes)
 - Investigating Rhino Shield-type ceramic coatings
 - Recommend we keep maintaining existing as long as we can

 the grocery store, etc.


